

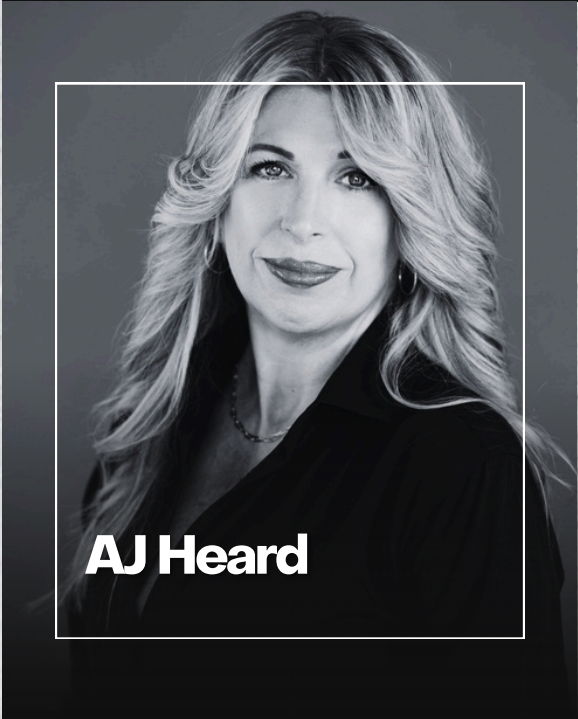
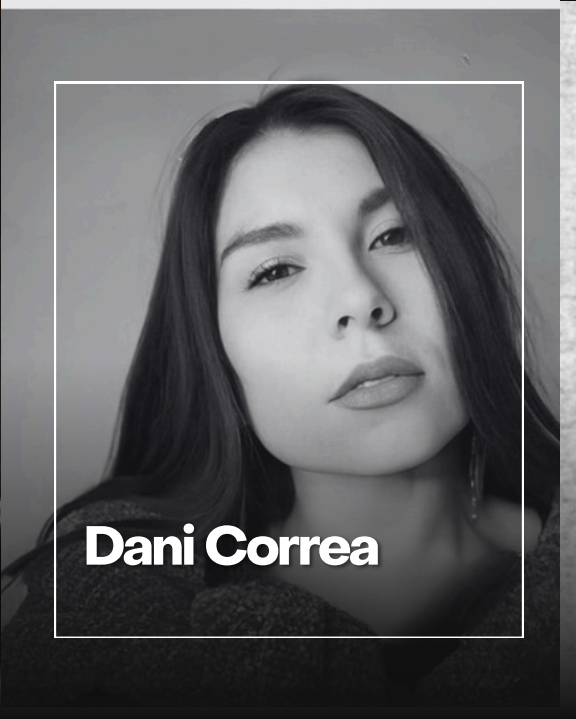
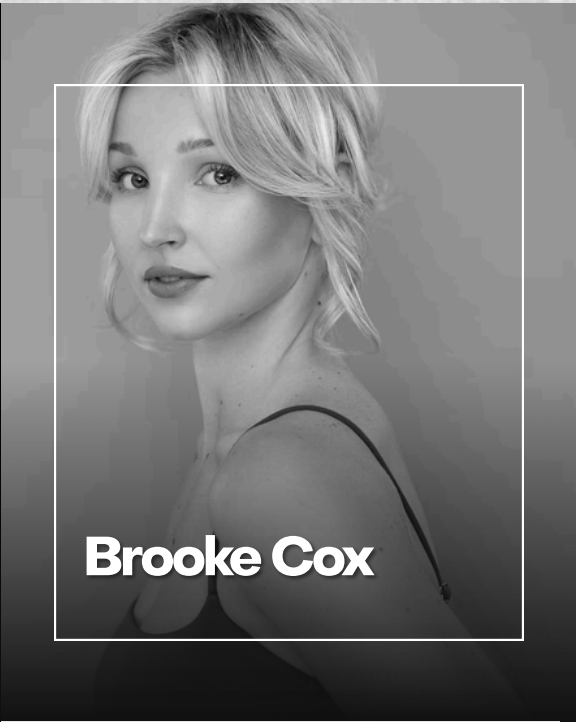
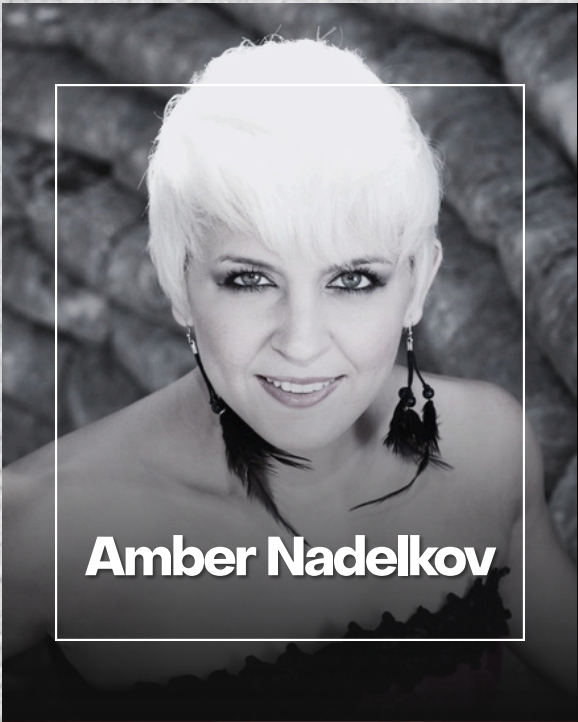
Dance Branson Presents

After spending many years expanding on her creative knowledge, vocabulary and experience in cities such as Tampa, New York City and Nashville, she maintained an active performing career at Walt Disney World in Orlando, FL where she performed as an Actors Equity dancer on Cinderella's Castle Stage at the Magic Kingdom and Beauty and the Beast, Live Onstage at Disney's Hollywood Studios. She performed alongside artists such as Disney's Descendants and Meghan Trainor for nationally televised Disney Christmas specials. Has danced back up for LeAnn Rimes, Deborah Cox, and Debbie Gibson for events and live performances.

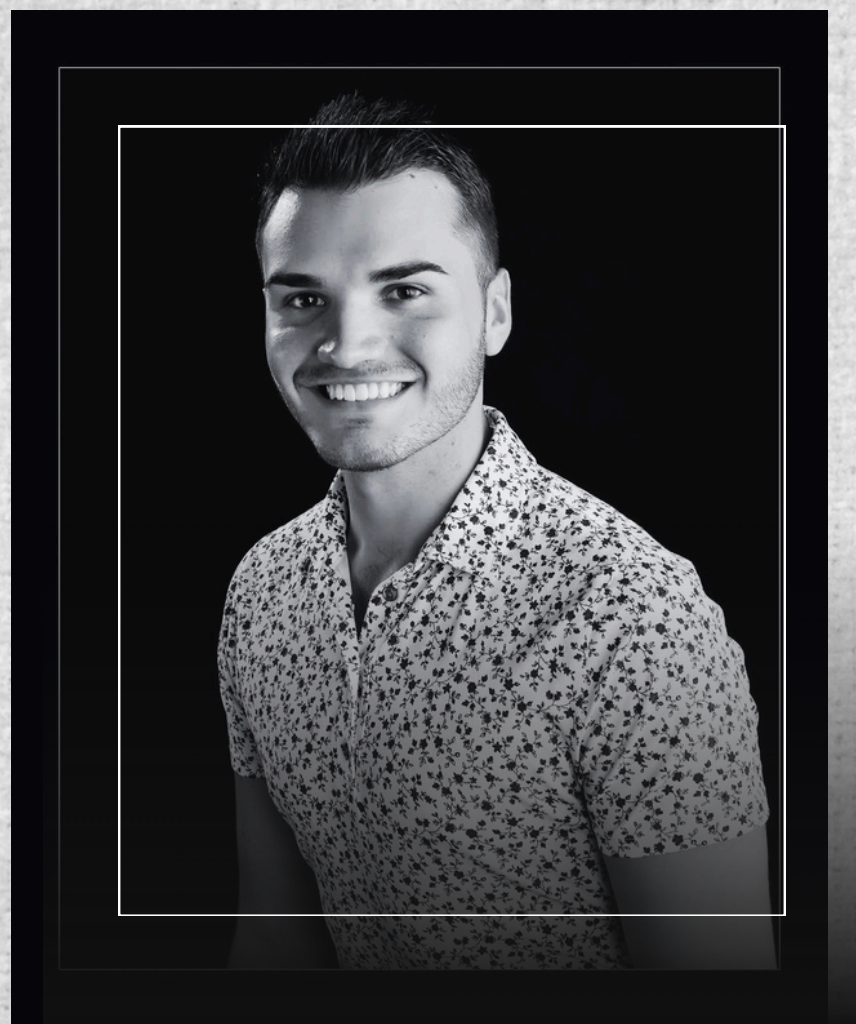

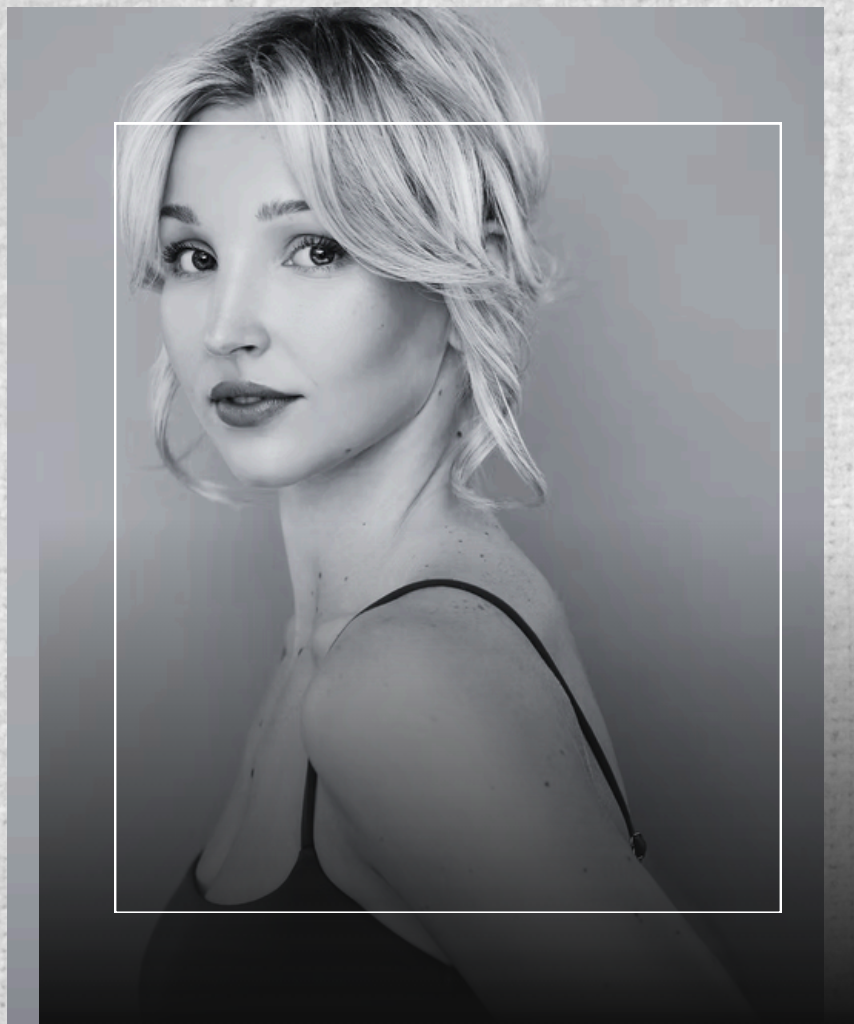

Manual "Lukky" Harvey is one of the Midwest's premier hip-hop instructors and choreographers, leading hip-hop programs for multiple studios throughout Missouri and Kansas while teaching workshops, intensives, and camps across the region.

He is the founder of the iPush Workshop Series and iPush theCOMMUNITY, organizations dedicated to bringing top industry professionals to the Midwest and investing in the next generation of dancers.

Signed with Clear Talent Group in Los Angeles, Manual regularly trains at renowned studios including Millennium Dance Complex and Movement Lifestyle.

His performance and choreography credits include projects with Jordan Fisher, Ginuwine, Tech N9ne, Krizz Kaliko, MacKenzie Nicole, and appearances in film, stage productions, and commercial campaigns.

Known for his high-energy classes and distinctive style, Manual emphasizes musicality, groove, movement quality, and authentic performance, inspiring dancers to move with confidence and purpose.

Tonya began dancing at age four in Waco, Texas, and landed her first professional role at just 14 in Oliver. She earned scholarships to the Debbie Reynolds Performing Arts Center, Gus Giordano Summer Intensive, and Tremaine before touring with Dance Caravan Dance Conventions and performing professionally throughout the US.

As a choreographer, Tonya has created work for artists including Mel and Pam Tillis, Brenda Lee, Jim Stafford, The Lennon Sisters, and Dino, as well as productions such as Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat, West Side Story, 9 to 5, and SHOUT the Musical. Her choreography has also been featured at Lincoln Center in New York, on USO Tours, cruise lines, theme parks, national television productions, and tours. Two of her productions were recognized among the Top Five Overall Theme Park Shows by the International Association of Amusement Parks and Attractions.

Tonya is the owner and artistic director of Dance Branson School of the Arts, where she has inspired dancers for over a decade. Her students have gone on to perform on Broadway, at the Tony Awards, in national tours, collegiate dance programs, and in Steven Spielberg's West Side Story. She is passionate about developing confident, well-rounded dancers and sharing her love of the art with every student.

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For over 25 years Danielle Lucia, known to her friends as Dani Dan has had a calling for dance. With a Colombian heritage it was natural way for her to be artistic and expressive.

Originally a freestyle street dancer, she found love in several styles and took the time to study each one. Including Ballroom, Ballet, Salsa, Hiphop and Krump.
